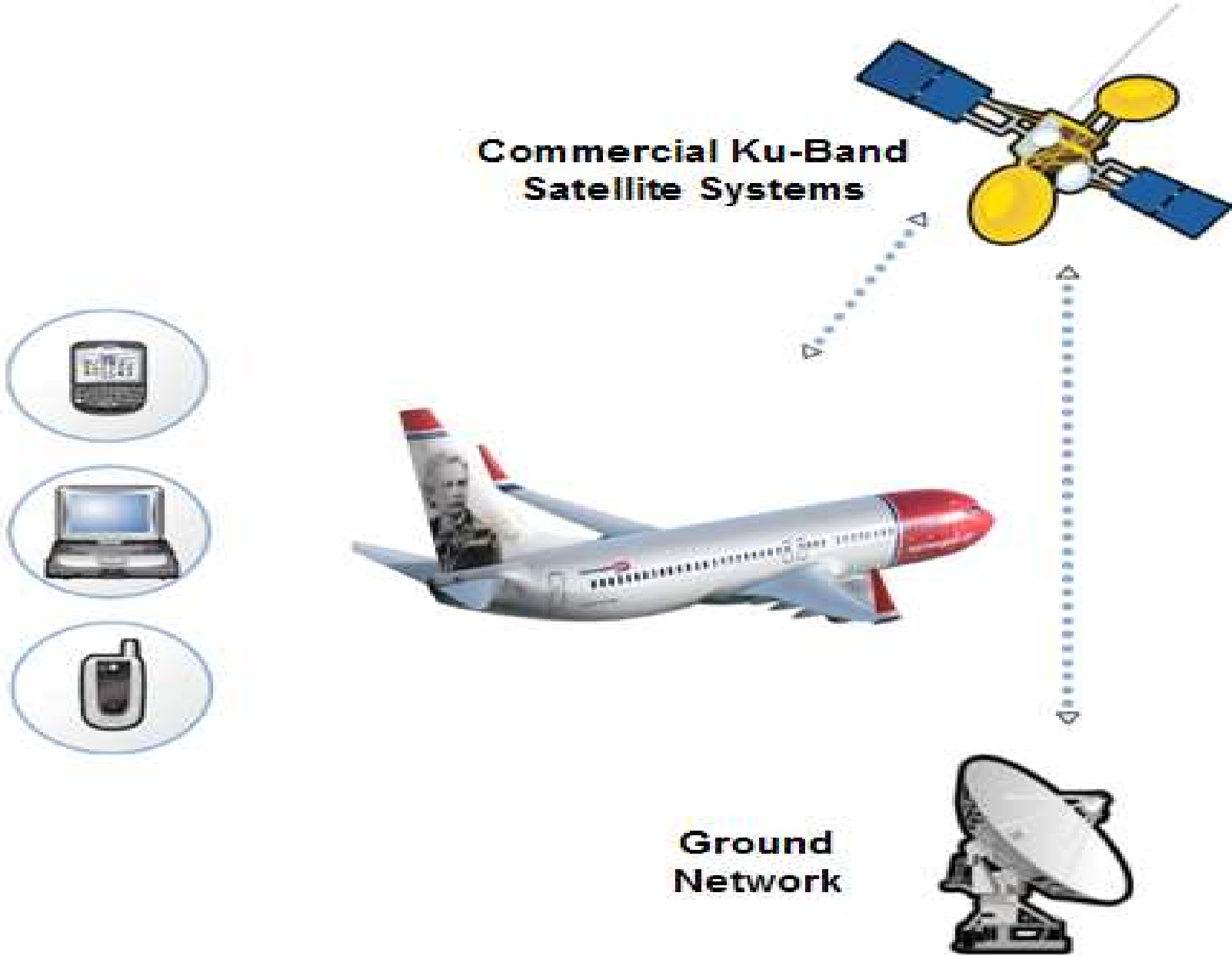
# Fist airline to offer in-flight WiFi in Europe



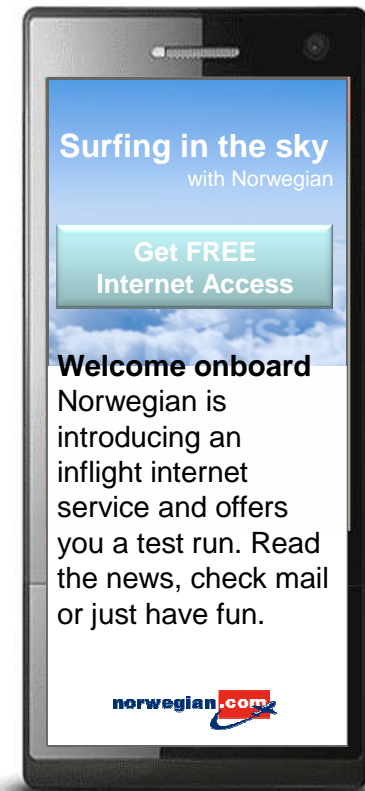
- 21 WiFi-enabled aircraft in 2011
- 11 aircraft in traffic by summer
- All new aircraft will have the WiFi system installed at our Stavanger base
- Service officially opened by Norwegian Minister Rigmor Aasrud, responsible for IT Affairs on February 8
- Free of charge during launch period
- Not decided on cost of service, but will be affordable
